Apparently and according to Manuel tells during his trial, his macabre killings were allegedly motivated by a curse. Manuel eases at the hearing that he can not control, something compels him to behave like a wild animal and Debora those poor people during the full moon, when the prosecutor asked to make a demonstration to the courtroom, said Romasanta "The curse lasts only thirteen years old and last week met the deadline and I was cured" ...

His first victim was the Sheriff of Leon, Vicente Fernandez, who was going to seize the store where he worked in those days, the two went for a walk apparently to talk, the Sheriff's wife saw them leave together, never to see her husband. A few miles PARDEV (a nearby town) found the body, the Court of Ponferrada fourteen months after Romasanta sentence to ten years in prison, but does not appear, immediate comment in absentia and beginning his search and seizure.

Romasanta is then installed in the small village of Rebordechao province of Orense, with the kindness that characterized him in his normal state, begin to "fix" the lives of these people earning their trust by promising them well in other towns, they were accompanied by the forest to their destination, a destination that never came to fruition as deep in the thick of it killed its victims to bite, helped by its massive claws to devour later. (At least partially)

At first all went well, continued his peddling mainly fat or lard, it is said that fat actually came from that obtained from their victims, slowly over time, the neighbors began to feel uncomfortable with their presence, observed with increasing frequency, of each person or persons accompanying Romasanta on those trips, never heard from again. Only had news that Manuel wrote the letters himself, family members and try to reassure them so not to arouse suspicion.

This terrible monster intelligence unusual for the time, realized that was not well seen and decided to change and go to sell their "articles" to Portugal and its provinces, where in addition to selling butter, also sold the belongings of his previous victims. In fact this was also another reason that caused suspicion among the population in more than one occasion, came to recognize clothing and personal belongings of their relatives among the objects that sold Romasanta ... Portugal was not his only destination, Lugo walked, Castilla, Leon and even Toledo, where he would later be imprisoned.

In his flight was leaving more and more murders until Escalona (Toledo) was captured and tried in Allariz, admitted killing nine people, although the true figure is not known, other theories are that reached a thirteen fatalities but as we say this is undoubtedly one of the many mysteries surrounding the shadow of this sinister werewolf ...

The trial lasted about a year and April 6, 1853 was issued to end the death penalty sentence by the judge Allariz, condemning him to garrote and a thousand real compensation per victim.

The lawyer Romasanta (advised by a hypnotist named Philip) claims that can not be sure it is the real murderer by a simple confession as no real evidence that he was the perpetrator of the crimes sought mercy to the very Queen of Spain Elizabeth II taking the case for review to the Supreme Court of Justice.
